JNTU CIVIL BARRACKS
Built in year 1946 and exhibited on July 16th 1946 by Hon'ble T.S. Avinashilingam, education minister, government of Madras.



FOUNDATION STONE



RMC BUILDING
Constructed in the year 1886, The Maharaja of Pithapuram has donated the building for the purpose of building medical college in Kakinada.



AIR RAID SHELTER
Built in 1942 C.E during Second World War by the British government as a shelter for the soldiers to hide during bombing by air raids.



NAGINA MOSQUE
Built in 1892 and run by Muthavali, organisations of Mastics



MUNICIPAL CORPORATION
The Municipal corporation Building, built in 1866 by the Britishers was used as Municipal Council hall



JAMIA MOSQUE
Centralized Mosque in East and West Godavari Districts and property of the Wakf, built in 1898.



EAST GODAVRI DIST. ASSOCIATION
E.G. Dist. Association, laid a prominent role during the freedom moment having 100 years of history to its name built in 1916. Now serves as public library.



VICTORIA WATER WORKS
In 1903, given by Maharaja of Pithapuram, who donated 40 acres of land for the municipality for drinking water.



COLLECTORATE
Kakinada was developed and ruled by Dutch until the transfer of power to the British government in 1825.



OME BUILDING
Built in the year 1861 by the Maharaja of Pithapuram and Sri Raghupati Venkata Ratnam Naidu. The aim of the constructing the building was to reform the Hindu religion and to intellectual discipline of the religion.



BALA TRIPURA SUNDARI TEMPLE
Constructed in 19th Century which was laid by the Pithapuram Raja.



CRAIG MEMORIAL BAPTIST CHURCH
The year 1874, Craig Memorial Baptist Church was built by Missionary.



Mc LAURIN SCHOOL
Built on 23rd November 1911 by British Citizen REV. John Bates Mc Laurin, has founded the school for educating the poor.



CANADIAN BAPTIST MISSION SCHOOL
Constructed in the year 1874 by Mary bates Mac Laurin. It is the first high school of Godavari Districts.



MRO OFFICE
Built in the year 1866, previously called as Treasury Office from the British Period



CENTENARY ANDHRA BAPTIST CHURCH
Symbol of cross, built in 1904 by the Canadian Baptist Missionaries, said as mother of Churches



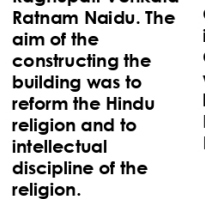
CHURCH OF ENGLAND
Established by the Missionaries in 1665. Called as St. Thomas CSI.



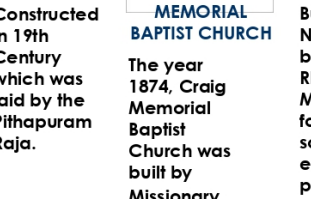
VISHNU TEMPLE
Constructed in 19th Century



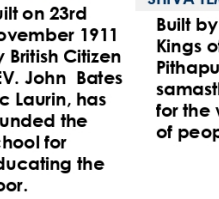
ST. ANN'S CHURCH
It was built in January 1839, run by the Missionaries



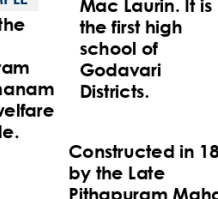
SRI VENU GOPAL SWAMY TEMPLE
