6. 200+ members, thousands of members including schools and institutes, 500+ heritage clubs and many volunteers all committed to preserving India's heritage

नागपुर. शहर में ऐतिहासिक, प्राचीन धरोहरों की भरमार है. इन धरोहरों का रखरखाव करने में प्रशासन की ओर से खासी कोताही बरती जाती है. उनका जतन करना तो दूर उनको हटाने का मामला प्रकाश में आया है. ऐतिहासिक धरोहरों की जिज्ञासुओं को जानकारी देने के लिये सतत हेरिटेज वॉकका आयोजन कर रही आर्किटेक्चरल संकुल संस्था की नितिका रामानी ने बताया कि प्राचीन मुरलीधर मंदिर के समक्ष आमराई शॉर्टकट एयरपोर्ट, खामला मार्ग के ऐतिहासिक विशाल चबूतरे को सड़क चौड़ाईकरण के नाम पर तोड़ दिया गया. दूसरे चबूतरे की भी सीढ़ियां उखाड़ी गईं. इन ऐतिहासिक प्राचीन धरोहरों को तोड़ने के संबंध में मनपा, पीडब्ल्यूडी, एयरपोर्ट अथारिटी, मिहान से चर्चा की गई. तब सबने इन्हें तोड़ने के संबंध में जानकारी नहीं होना बताते हुए गेंद एक दूसरे के पाले में डाल दी. आर्किटेक्चरल संकुल की ओर से शनिवार, 13 अप्रैल को सुबह 8 बजे मुरलीधर मंदिर के सामने, शॉर्टकट एयरपोर्ट मार्ग, खामला में मूक प्रदर्शन किया जाएगा. ऐतिहासिक प्राचीन धरोहर प्रेमियों से बड़ी संख्या में प्रदर्शन में शामिल होने की अपील की गई है.

Sakkardara – The forgotten heritage zone of Nagpur

Sakkardara is a south-eastern area of Nagpur, popularly known as the Chota Tajbagh area, was once an important area during the rule of the Bhonsle dynasty (1743-1818).



The Sakkardara precinct was developed by Sena Saheb Suba Raja Raghuji Bhonsle - II (1780-1816), as one of the 22 baghs built by him and later was used as a residential complex by Raja Bahadur Raghuji Bhonsle - IV. During its yesteryears, the Sakkardara precinct was fortified and housed -

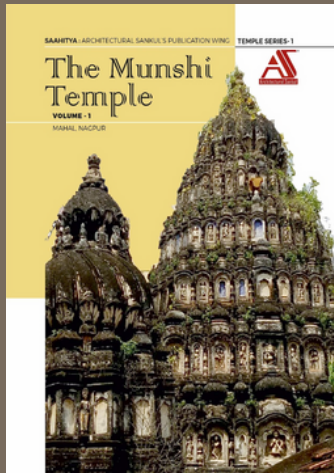
